Competition Details

1. Competitions are open to students who reside on the North side of Dublin or attend a music teacher in the area.
2. Candidates play **one piece** or movement of their own choice **not exceeding five minutes** duration.
3. Please note 'under 10' means 'aged 10 and under'. The same applies in all categories.
4. Candidates must qualify in age **on or before 28th April**
5. An original copy of the music must be provided for the adjudicator on the day of competition.
6. Candidates requiring accompanist must submit the music and extra fee (€20) **with this entry form**. This fee includes a short rehearsal on the day of the competition.
7. Candidates must register in the office thirty minutes before their competition is due to begin.
8. The closing date for receipt of music entries is **Saturday 14th April**
9. The decision of the adjudicator is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
10. Previous First prize winners may not compete in the same category again.
