# Competition Rules

1. Competitions are open to students who reside on the **North side of Dublin** or attending a north side music teacher
2. Candidates play **one piece** or movement of their own choice **not exceeding five minutes** duration.
3. Please note 'under 10' means 'aged 10 and under'. (The same applies in all categories)
4. Candidates must **qualify in age on 12th May 2023**
5. An original copy of the music must be provided for the adjudicator on the day of competition.
6. Candidates must register in the office thirty minutes before their competition is due to begin.
7. The **closing date** for receipt of music entries is **Friday 21st April**
8. The decision of the adjudicator is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
9. Previous first prize winners may not compete in the same category again.
10. Accompanist can only be provided if a clear hard copy of the music comes in with the entry. Digital transfer not accepted.
